Dear Delphos City School Parents and Guardians,

Today, Delphos City Schools decided that Jefferson High School will begin phasing into a blended learning model, which includes in-person instruction and learning remotely from home. **This change begins on Tuesday, October 13, 2020.** This plan does NOT impact or change the schedule for any high school student attending ACESC, Synergy, or Vantage Career Center.

We will utilize the following schedule until further notice. DCS administration will continue to monitor this situation and make adjustments as needed.

October 12 - All high school students learning remotely

Beginning Tuesday, October 13th.

- **Grades 9-10** will attend school in person on Mondays, Wednesdays and alternate Fridays (with their first Friday being October 16th).
- **Grades 11-12** will attend school in person on Tuesdays, Thursdays and alternate Fridays (with their first Friday being October 23).

Remote Learning Days

On days when students are not attending school in person, they will be required to log on to google classroom and complete the lesson activity for the day. Teachers will have the lesson activity posted by 10 AM. Teachers will provide more information to the students at that time.

Mobile Hotspots

Delphos City Schools is in the process of ordering mobile hotspots. We will be issuing mobile hotspots free to those families that have internet connection issues. Mr. Suever will be sending out a google form to all high school students in need of consistent, reliable wifi. They should be available for pick up by the end of the week.

Meal Service

Grab and go meals will be available to students learning remotely. Students not in school that day can pick up their lunch from 11:00 - 11:30 AM from the high school. Lunch pick up will be located at the northwest entrance door.

Additional Student Support

Students on IEPs may have the opportunity to attend more frequently. The Intervention Specialist will reach out to the parents soon.
