Dear Delphos Community,

The Delphos Board of Education has voted to place a .50% traditional income tax levy on the ballot for March 17, 2020. The purpose of this levy is to continue funding for general operating expenses of the district supporting all current programs and services we offer to our students and for our community. This levy will support our district to remain fiscally healthy and allows us to plan for our future with continuous opportunities for our students. Local levies provide over 58% of our district revenue and with your support, we can maintain the momentum we have been experiencing for the past several years. This momentum is due to the relationships, cooperation, vision and generosity of our community who have come together to help define our school system and foster pride.

A few initial points for our community to understand:

1. DCS has one of the lowest local tax efforts in the area. The passage of this levy competitively aligns us with neighboring school districts.
2. Funds secured from this levy will allow all programs, teachers and services to continue and allow for some growth in strategic areas.
3. Schools and communities are interlocked-strong communities support their public schools.
4. Support for this levy costs \$20 per month for someone earning \$50K per year.
5. Please exercise your right to vote on 3/17/2020.
